
Code of Conduct

Updated September 25, 2026

Branson Meadows Events is a place for families, concertgoers, conference attendees, and community groups to enjoy themselves. Everyone who enters the building, including guests, performers, exhibitors, vendors, and contractors, agrees to follow this Code of Conduct.

What we expect

- Treat guests, performers, and staff with courtesy and respect.
- Follow the directions of Branson Meadows staff and security at all times.
- Keep language and gestures family-friendly everywhere in the building.
- Harassment, threats, and discrimination of any kind are not tolerated.
- Dress appropriately for a family-friendly venue.
- Drink responsibly. Alcohol is served only to guests 21 and older with valid ID.
- Keep aisles, stairways, and exits clear.
- Respect the building, furnishings, and equipment.
- Supervise children at all times. Guests under 18 must be with an adult.

Items not permitted

- Weapons of any kind, except for on-duty law enforcement
- Outside alcohol
- Outside food and beverages, unless approved for your event
- Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia
- Fireworks, sparklers, and anything with an open flame
- Laser pointers, noisemakers, and air horns
- Drones
- Professional cameras and recording equipment, unless approved by the event organizer
- Glitter, confetti, and silly string

Bags may be inspected at the door. Items not permitted must be returned to your vehicle or will be refused entry.

Smoking

The building is smoke-free and vape-free. Smoking is allowed only in the designated outdoor area.

Exhibitors and vendors

- Stay within your assigned booth or table space and keep aisles clear.
 - Sell and promote only from your assigned space.
 - Amplified sound, sampling, and giveaways need approval from the event organizer.
 - Load in and out through the loading docks during your scheduled times only.
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Enforcement

Branson Meadows Events may refuse entry to, or remove without refund, anyone who does not follow this Code of Conduct or whose behavior puts others at risk. Individual events may add their own rules, which will be posted or shared by the event organizer.
